Macarthur Careers Expo 2018

Careers Advisers Macarthur Schools (CAMS) Network in partnership with Macarthur Workplace Learning Program (MWLP) will be organising the annual **Macarthur Careers Expo** for students in years 10, 11 & 12. The Careers Expo will be open for students from Macarthur schools from 9:00am to 2:15pm on **Thursday 7th June 2018** at **Club Menangle**.

In operation for over 17 years the Macarthur Careers Expo is an integral part of career development for students by providing them with access to a broad range of current, high quality career-based information, that will assist in their decisions regarding future education, training and employment opportunities.

For many young people in the community it is the most direct way to access the latest information, advice and expertise to assist in career exploration and guidance.

Students will have the opportunity to;

- Interact with **100 exhibitors** from a range of areas including further education and training providers, government support services, business and industry
- Attend **'focus sessions'** covering topics such as TAFE enrolment, UAC processes and industry awareness
- Access **hands on, interactive displays** from TAFE and private colleges

For the 2018 expo there will be an entrance fee per student;

Government Schools

Less than 200 students- \$5.00 per head
Over 200 students- \$4.00 per head

• Non-Government Schools

Less than 200 students- \$7.00 per head
Over 200 students- \$6.00 per head

Transport to the event will be organised by each school, therefore costs will be organised within each school. Students attending from your school will also require sufficient staff for general supervision.

We ask where possible that your **Careers Advisor** be present for the entirety of the day, as they are required for a range of tasks to ensure the day runs smoothly. The event also provides them with the opportunity to collect the latest career resources for their own professional development.

We will liaise further with your Careers Advisor over the next few weeks and look forward to your school being involved again this year.
